- 3. Perform for Dances and Events: POB plays music for contra dances and similar events, a few times a year. Participation in this activity is optional.

HOW TO JOIN

- 3. Members are encouraged to learn the list of core tunes so they can play these tunes at dance tempo, either by ear or from sheet music.
- 4. The list of core tunes changes over time, by consensus, based on suggestions from our members.
